# MAYOR'S CLOSING COMMENTS:

Mayor McConnell advises that he and Town Clerk, Lisa Purvis met with FEMA and the Orange Street Box Culvert final documents have been signed and the Town can now start the design work. FEMA will fund 75% Federal and 12.5% State with the Town (local) responsible for 12.5%. Town Clerk, Lisa Purvis will be filing for a hardship which is available for small Towns and if that is approved the project will be 100% funded. Ms. Purvis will also be filing for DAC Category Z funds which is for the Town's administration work on the project and that will be 5% of whatever the total project cost is.
