Nassau County Office of Management and Budget Director, Justin Stankiewicz speaks about the Nassau County Board of County Commissioners considering the implementation of the five cent gas tax. If the five cent gas tax is adopted it will increase transportation revenues by approximately \$1.6 million dollars annually with 4% going to the Town of Hilliard. Currently there are 31 counties that levy the five cent gas tax. The Board of County Commissioners will be voting on an Ordinance implementing a five cent gas tax on Monday, July 10, 2017.
