ITEM-10 Concurrency Application – Mr. Bobby Franklin/American Legion

Mr. Bobby Franklin is present to request concurrency to run approximately 341 feet of 2" water line from US1 to the property line of the future American Legion building and the other items listed on his concurrency application for the American Legion, which are as follows:

- 1. Building Permit Application
- 2. Zoning changes or exceptions to property
- 3. 501 C Exemptions
- 4. Waive System Development Charge

Mayor McConnell reads letters from Representative Cord Byrd and Senator Aaron Bean supporting the American Legion Post 401.

Council President Beasley advises that we never once have disallowed the American Legion to build within the Town limits, we have only disallowed them to serve liquor within the Town limits.

Councilman Pickett advises that they would be allowed to serve beer and wine just not liquor.

Mayor McConnell advises that would be in violation of our current ordinance as it only allows for restaurants to service beer and wine for on site consumption.

Councilman Wollitz questions how it will affect fair share going from a 2 inch line to a 6 inch line.

Councilman Bailey is in favor of waiving the System Development Charge with a future use clause that if the American Legion chooses to stop leasing the building then the owner will have to then pay the System Development Charge based on the future use of the building.

Councilman Wollitz questions again how it will affect share fair going from a 2 inch line to a 6 inch line.

Town Attorney, Sherri Renner advises that she would like to review the fair share section of the Zoning Code and other sections of the Town Code before a decision is made regarding all of the items requested tonight.
